

SECTION VI - HEALTH HAZARD DATA

EFFECTS OF OVEREXPOSURE: Excess ingestion may lead to respiratory depression, extreme somnolence progressing to stupor or coma, maximally constricted pupils, skeletal muscle flaccidity, cold and clammy skin, bradycardia or hypotension. Apnea, circulatory collapse, cardiac arrest, and death may occur.
